Types of Visuals

What are our variables?



Dependent variables

- These are variables that we control
- Appear in the x-axis of graphs
- E.g. Branches, Employees



Independent variables

- These are generated as a result of the dependent variable, and therefore are not in our control.
- This is what we are measuring and appear in the y-axis
- E.g. Revenue



What are we trying to show?

- Comparison
- Proportion
- Relationship



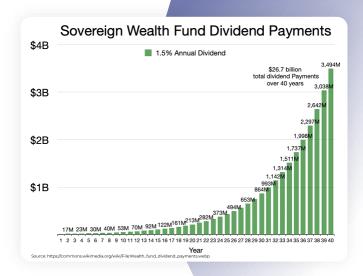

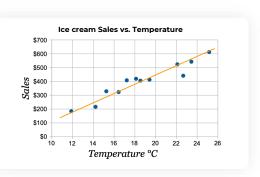




Types of Visuals: Correlation

Correlation ≠ Causation

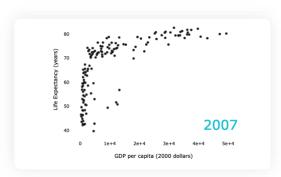
C causes A and B

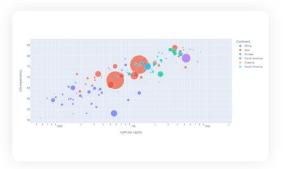




Types of Visuals: Bubble Charts

Life expectancy vs. GDP per Capita

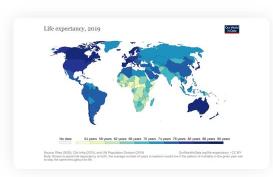

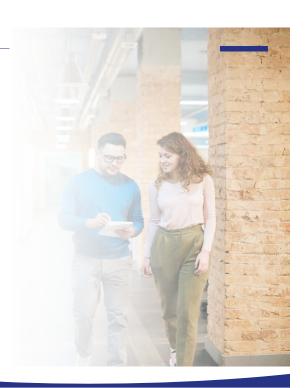






Sector Analytics

- Using financial and macroeconomic metrics, organizations can project expected performances in a given sector.
- Requires a holistic approach to data analytics:
 - o Demographic insights
 - Salary / spending power
 - o Time series analysis to assess actual business cycle
 - Financial modeling, potentially using machine learning
- Access to the right data (and verifying it!) can present challenges.

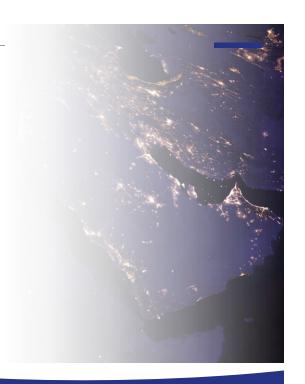






Geographic Segmentation

- Crucial aspect behind growing a portfolio
- If we control for demographics and GDP, what role does the physical location play in financial performance?
- Areas of consideration include:
 - o Communication preferences
 - o Major industries withing a territory
 - Level of interconnectedness with other geographies

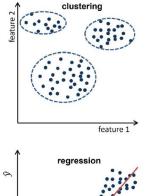


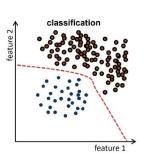

- This allows their investment team to be more agile when responding to the market.

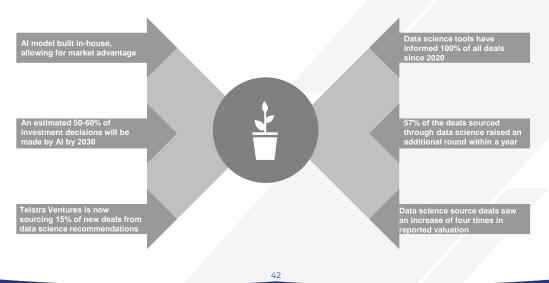
Blackrock uses ML to forecast market reaction Blackrock uses NLP and large language models to analyze text documents, such as earnings calls, to forecast market reaction.

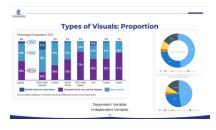

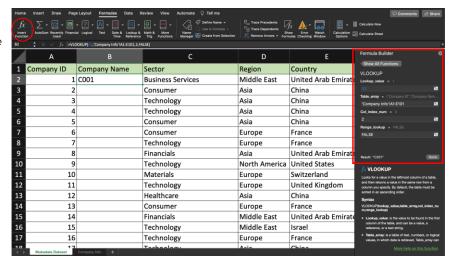






VLOOKUP

- When in doubt, say it out loud



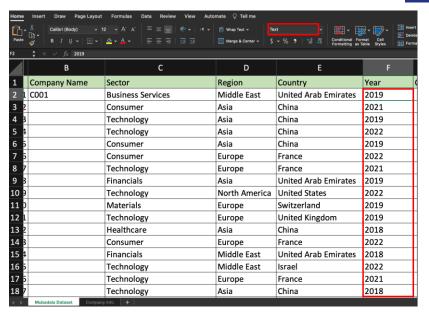

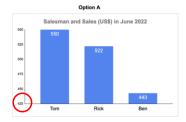
